The Pulse

The current Covid 19 pandemic continued to impact our activities during the last months.. Team morale is good.

Clinic Activities:

During the months of November and December 2021

Remote visits:20-30% in person visits: 70-80%.

As a result of the current COVID 19 surge, the clinic has shifted to mostly phone appointments.

20-30% in person 70-80: remote visits

HR concerns:

- Disengaged staff handed their resignation on December 13 2021

Dashboard

- November: total visits and NP visits number should remain at this level for the foreseeable future
- December. The drop in numbers was expected as multiple staff were on vacation during the holidays
- Total patient panel:2424 (+29,this number includes intakes scheduled for November 2021)

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Capital Expansion:

- We currently have 2 potential sites: 390 McNabb and the expansion of our current site.
- Actively searching for new potential site. So far, 1 realtor explained that there is no new suitable commercial space available.
- Currently, the only option we can afford is the expansion of our current location. However, this option (3671 sq.ft) is significantly smaller than the recommended clinic size from MOH i.e 5010 sq.ft..
- The building committee is meeting this month to discuss a strategy to secure more operational funding
